approached for advice by a Club Member whose initiation deposit was
being paid in installments, regarding payments that may be due in the
near future. I understand the concern and followed up with the Club
office to get a list of other members who might be in this difficult
position, i.e. deciding about paying the next installment in the face
of the likely demise of BBG. Your name was on that list, correctly or
incorrectly, and that is why I included you on this email.

I have spoken with BBG management and learned that they plan to send
out a letter to each of you in July asking for the next installment
payment under the threat of loss of membership if it is not paid within
30 days of that letter. I also learned that Joey Garon had told at
least some of you in months past that you did not have to pay these
installments until the issue of the Resignation Refund Policy was
resolved.

Our advice to you for the moment is not to do anything until you
receive this letter. We will revisit the issue after receipt of the
letter.
